You have the power to approve the Moose Lake plan for responsible development, so that government, industry and our community can get back to working together, as we've done for over 30 years.

We believe Moose Lake can be protected all while the in-situ resource is developed responsibly. Together, let's send a signal to Canada and the rest of the world that energy development can be a tool for reconciliation and a way to bring prosperity to Indigenous communities.

And so, we invite you, appropriate Ministers and Moose Lake area stakeholders to join us at the Moose Lake Together Summit to advance responsible growth and protect Moose Lake.
